Health

Through initiatives like ACCESS2Health kiosks and smart pods, CVS Project Health, the Summer Immunization Tour, and several others, we've helped ensure that all residents, regardless of socioeconomic status, have convenient access to essential medical services.

Veterans

Honoring the profound sacrifices of our esteemed veterans, Precinct2gether offers unwavering support during their transition into civilian life. This support includes a comprehensive array of impactful initiatives, such as personalized counseling services, assistance in accessing veteran benefits, and no- or low-cost medical care. As an example, our "Give Vets a Smile" program, in partnership with UT Health Houston's School of Dentistry and the Cizik School of Nursing, provided nine veterans with \$30,000 worth of free dental care. Additionally, we honor our vets by hosting several special events throughout the year.

Youth

Dedicated to narrowing educational disparities and fostering enriching experiences, our youth programs serve low-income, marginalized, and underserved Precinct 2 residents. Our relentless mission is to empower them with a robust combination of resources and unwavering support, through opportunities that include afterschool activities, educational camps and field trips, and immersive learning experiences.

Parks & Recreation

We proudly champion our precinct's 55 well-maintained, vibrant parks and public spaces. Through strategic investments in their preservation and enhancement, we create safe spaces for residents of all ages to enjoy recreational activities while fostering a sense of community connection. Activities include adult arts & crafts, fitness classes, group games, gardening, and sports.

TeeUp2gether Golf Tournament

Thanks to our supporters, we were able to resurrect our charity golf tournament, rebranding as TeeUp2gether. In October of 2023, participants met on the green at Bay Oaks Country Club to help us drive change for our residents while networking with like-minded individuals. Proceeds from the tournament support our Seniors 55+ programs, youth events, spring break and summer camps, and park and recreation programs.

Special Thanks

Tornado Relief Home Repair Program

Thanks to a \$300,000 grant from The **Astros Foundation** and additional funding from **AARP**, Precinct2gether was able to provide repairs to homes owned by Seniors 55+, many of whom are disabled or have no insurance. These homes sustained damage during the EF-3 tornado that tore through Precinct 2's Deer Park, Pasadena, Baytown, and LaPorte communities on January 24, 2023. Because of this generous grant, we worked with Minority Business contractors located in Precinct 2 to repair damaged roofs, siding, broken windows, and interiors. But most importantly, we were able to help restore normalcy for deserving residents.



Tree Planting & Park Improvement

With the help and generosity of **Houston Carbon Capture & Storage (CCS) Alliance** and the hard work of more than 50 volunteers, we planted 400 trees at Partnership Park in Pasadena, helping beautify a treasured outdoor space that was devastated by the January tornado. The project also included the installation of a dog park. Additionally, Commissioner Garcia recognized Houston CCS Alliance with a proclamation, commending their direct engagement with local communities and their efforts to raise awareness about carbon capture and storage technology throughout the Houston area.

Thrive2gether Micro Grant Program

Administered by Precinct2gether, this program awards funds to nonprofits, community organizations, and civic associations who can demonstrate their benefit to Precinct 2 communities.
